Park Description

Broemmelsiek Park was named for the family of Jack Broemmelsiek, who resided on the property for more than 30 years and dedicated their lives to promoting conservation activities. The park is 494 acres and features many natural recreation amenities for family fun. The park opened in 2007 and offers more than 7 miles of multi-use trails that are open to hiking, biking and equestrian use. Nature preserves, picnic pavilions, an astronomy viewing area, clean family friendly restrooms with running water are just a few features in this park.

Course Description

The race starts up a paved climb then flows on to a loop of fast and flowy hardpack single track through the woodlands including some creek crossings and field sections. Kids race will be a separate shorter loop with a few challenges.
